Principal's Report/Vice Principal's Report

- We have a new logo. The new logo has been approved and will be used from now on.
- The PALS program is coming to Unsworth. (Parents as Learning Support)
- Grade 4s – MDI (Middle Years Development Index). This is a survey for grade 4 students to help understand the child as a whole person rather than just a student.
