Emergency Contact Forms

The student verification forms will be sent home when the classes are confirmed. Please update, sign and return these forms by Friday, **September 15**th. These forms are very important as the school depends on the information you provide to us to contact you or your designate in the case of an emergency. Additionally, if you moved over the summer and changed your address on the form, please return the form with a utility bill or a copy of your driver's license with the new address.

Morning Arrival / Dismissal Times

We ask that our parents and students are aware of the morning and end of the day supervision times and that parents ensure that students do not arrive at the school prior to 8:00 a.m., unless supervised by a parent/caregiver. At the end of the day, we direct all students go home at the 2:15 dismissal bell unless supervised by a parent/caregiver. We ask that children do not stay and play at the school at the end of the day.

Medications / Health Concerns

If you require the school to administer any kind of medication to your child, an authorization form must be completed first. Please see the office to get the forms, which must be **signed by the family doctor and parent.** Please notify the school office and your child's teacher if there are any health issues that we need to be aware of. As we have students with severe allergies to nuts, **our school is Nut Aware.** We ask that all students please <u>avoid bringing peanut butter to school, due to the stickiness and oil that peanut butter contains,</u> it can be easily transferred to many surfaces and objects in the classroom and throughout the school. If a child does accidently bring a peanut based item for lunch, we ask that they inform the teacher or Noon Hour Supervisor.

Child Custody / Court Orders

Please inform your child's classroom teacher and the office regarding any family custody conditions or revised court documents. The office must have current copies of court orders, custody access documents, and/or documents that limit or restrict access, in order for the school staff to support compliance.



PARKING

A reminder that the parking lot and student safety is a school community responsibility. Please be mindful of the following:

- The curb side lane is the Drop off lane only and is meant to allow for continuous flow and movement. Please pick up and drop off in the drop off zone only, which is in the curved part of the lane, in front of the flagpoles. Students waiting to be picked-up need to wait in front of the flagpoles which allows for the vehicle to pull up, the child to quickly load and the vehicle then pulls forward and merges into the Thru lane.
- Please do not park or wait anywhere along the curb side lane.

 Particularly at the end of the drop off lane. Curb side parking blocks the flow and purpose of the drop off lane and causes a backup of vehicles and frustration for drivers, thus causing unsafe conditions for our students;
- If your child is not waiting and able to immediately get into the vehicle, please loop around the parking lot and re-enter the drop off lane until you are able to pick up, or find a parking stall to park or wait.
- Please remind children to use the crosswalk both in the school parking lot and to cross Unsworth Rd.

- Please return all the Library books that were borrowed over the Summer Holiday.
- School Supply Reminder Cost is only \$20 + an additional \$5 for a planner if your child's teacher requires them. Please note that due to a fire in the warehouse of the supplier, there will be a delay in receiving our planners. Your child's teacher will arrange an effective way to communicate and share classroom information.
- Criminal Record Checks are necessary for volunteering in the school and on Field Trips. If you had a CRC done in the past 4 years, your Criminal Check is currently valid.
- Road Safety Use appropriate crossings to gain access to school.
- "Wheels up" reminder to students when you arrive on school property, all bikes, scooters, rollerblades need to be carried or walked. This is done to keep everybody safe while arriving and exiting school.
