#### **School Supplies:**

We have been able to purchase school supplies for students in bulk and have subsidized the cost to parents by using the family affordability funding this year. We ask that you please pay \$20.00 for school supplies through the online payment system that was emailed out to all parents from the school district. Some classes will be using planners and the cost of these is \$5.00. Teachers will communicate home what you need to pay for.

#### Student Cell Phone Use:

Students are not permitted to use personal cell phones during the school day (8:20-2:18). If students need to contact home, they can ask an adult for support to do so.

Students may only use their phone during the day if the teacher invites them to use it for an educational purpose in the classroom.

No photos or video are to be taken using a cell phone during the day.

If a student is found using their phone during the school day, staff may confiscate it until the end of the day and then return it to the student. Repeated offenses may mean a plan is developed to help support the student with their phone use choices.

#### **Verification Forms:**
